

2017 Richmond Friends School Trueblood Preschool Summer Camps

June 12 - 16 Wheels, Speed and Transportation Fun



Join us for a week of boats, planes, trains and automobiles as we transform Trueblood into a fun maze of roads, runways, lakes, and bridges. We will both use pre-made vehicles to test some physics with ramp height and speed, build our own vehicles to float and fly. Even test how water affects the speed of vehicles. A special field trip to ride a city bus and possibly other special vehicle visits will also be planned. This will be a fun week of both outside and inside play, a creek walk, water play, bus ride, and lots and lots of wheels! A special "drive-in" viewing of a themed movie will even be shown.

June 19-23 Forest Explorers

Join us for a week of trail hikes, prairie exploration, creek walks, water play, and more. We will observe and learn from the forest, prairie, and creek around Trueblood. We will also visit the Joseph Moore Museum for nature lessons and fun. We would like each child to bring a plain white t-shirt to do natural dyeing this week which they will be able to bring home on Friday.

June 26-30 Theater, Storytelling and the Arts

Join us this week as our youngest students learn how to act, tell a story with puppets, and perform fun interactive songs. The campers will also work to design their own "sets" and props and create a variety of different art projects using many unique materials from leaves, sticks, and sand to food art, shapes, even photography. A Friday finale of performances will be included. **This week we will have an extra supplies fee of \$10 per child. Fee to be paid when you sign up for this camp.**

July 5,6,7 Mini-Camp from Farm to Table Fee is \$60 for camp/\$110 for aftercare

Join us along with volunteers from the Miller Farm on Earlham Campus to do some gardening and tasting of foods that can be grown in Indiana. We will spend at least part of the day outside at the farm each day.

July 10-14 Space Camp

Join us as we transform to a special space training center where we will learn about gravity, aerodynamics, rockets, space travel, food in space and more. We will be determining our weight on other planets, making and launching our own rockets, building our space suits, learning about the stars and planets at the JMM planetarium, and more. 3,2,1, blastoff to fun!

July 17-21 Pre-historic Era

Join us as we travel back in time to the pre-historic era with dinosaurs, volcano's, and so much more. We will be making paper mache volcanos and dinosaur eggs, doing some art with mud and dirt, even making our own stone sculptures. We again will be visiting the JMM to examine some fossils from this era.

July 24-28 It is a Jungle Out There

Join us for the last week of camp as we visit the Rainforest and the animals that live there. Join us for a week of colorful art, music, animals, water, and fun. Given it is hot in the jungle, we hope that we can include water play daily.

Trueblood Summer Camps are geared to children age 3 who are potty-trained to completed Kindergarten. Camps (except for the week of July 4th) are 5 days a week from 8am to 12:00pm (drop off between 7:30 and 8 and pick up between noon and 12:30) Cost is \$115 per week to be paid in advance. Campers who need extended care from 7:30-5:30 daily will add an additional \$60 a week for a total of \$175 weekly. Full day students must bring a sack lunch.

Each camp will have a minimum number of students. Once the set minimum number of students is reached you will be notified. Fees are due by Monday of the first day of camp. You must cancel at least 1 week in advance to not be charged camp fees. Our staff will be purchasing supplies and snacks in advance of each camp.
