<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Package WASHABLE markers 1 dry erase marker 1 Ream of copy paper (white or colored) 4-6 Glue Sticks 8 inexpensive washcloths or kitchen dish clothes (for reusable napkins; do not label; light colors preferred) 2 boxes Kleenex 1- 3 ring binder, ½ - 1 inch (labeled with child’s name) 25 or more sheet protectors for use in the 3-ring binder Refillable water bottle (labeled with child’s name) Boys: 1 box Ziplock style freezer bags (quart size) and 1 can foam shaving cream Girls: 1 box Ziplock style bags (gallon size) and 1 large bottle of bubbles <p>Optional: 1 bottle liquid dishwasher soap, 1 bottle Dawn liquid dish soap, 1 bottle vegetable oil, 1 bottle vinegar</p> <p>For students’ cubbies: Rain boots or second pair of shoes and socks, sweatshirt or jacket, 2 complete changes of clothes with shirt/underwear, shorts or pants. When a change is made, the wet or dirty clothes go home for washing. Please send in a replacement set.</p> <p>Full day students need to bring: Blanket and pillow for rest time (small stuffed animal and crib sheet to cover the cot are also ok); lunch daily with an afternoon snack packed in lunchbox.</p> <p>We encourage the use of reusable containers and utensils from home. Let’s be kind to our earth and reduce trash! *Families will sign up for morning snacks on a weekly basis*</p>	<p>Shared Supplies:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1 set of regular pencils (sharpened) 1 ream (500 sheets) of white copy paper 8 1/2” by 11” 1 box of Kleenex markers: 2 sets of regular Crayola markers and 1 set of thin line Crayola markers glue: 1 bottle of Elmer’s brand school glue and 1 pack of Elmer’s brand glue sticks 2 rolls of scotch tape <p><i>(Elmer’s and Crayola are preferable as they seem to have longer shelf lives over other brands!)</i></p> <p>Personal supplies –<u>please label all items with your child’s name:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1 pocket folder (any color or images) 1 red pocket folder 3 spiral notebooks with lined paper - 8 1/2” by 11” a water bottle that will stay at school a complete change of clothing placed in a labeled plastic bag <p>PLEASE BRING THESE ITEMS TO SCHOOL ON ORIENTATION/WORK DAY PRIOR TO THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL.</p>	<p>Personal Supplies- <u>please label these items you’re your child’s name:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Change of clothes, zipped up in an extra-large Ziploc baggie with your child's name on it: 1 pair of pants (not shorts); 1 long-sleeved shirt; 2 pairs of underwear; 1 pair of socks Plastic pencil box (approximately 8.5" x 6"). <u>Bring to school empty.</u> 4 folders with pockets. (Not plastic) Write name on the outside FRONT cover. (Two are for my classroom, one is for Spanish class, and one is for music class). 1 sturdy plastic cup (no attached straws or lids) 1 sturdy plastic plate (without dividers) 1 backpack, to be brought to school every day <p>Shared Supplies- <u>please DO NOT label:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1 ream of white printer paper 1 pack of Crayola Super Tips Washable Markers (pack of 50) 1 large box of tissues 1 pump bottle of hand soap 1 roll of plain, all-purpose, masking tape 1 container of table wipes 2 thick chisel-tip black Expo brand dry erase markers First graders: 1 sandbox-related toy (shovel, funnel, etc.) Second graders: 1 washcloth 2 composition books (not spiral) - traditional marbled style in black and white. These are for Spanish and music class. First Graders and students brand new to RFS only. Second graders will continue using their same Spanish and music composition books. <p>BRING SUPPLIES ON THE FIRST FULL DAY OF SCHOOL - <u>NOT WORKDAY.</u></p>

Personal Supplies:

- 1 box #2 pencils, sharpened
- Individual pencil sharpener (small enough to fit in the palm of your hand)
- Large pink or white eraser
- Crayons
- Colored pencils
- 1-2 ink pens
- 3 glue sticks
- 5 pocket folders – one each of: red, yellow, green, blue, purple
- 4 Spiral notebooks
- 2 Composition Notebooks- for Music and Spanish
- 1-2 clean, old socks (to use as erasers for dry erase boards)

Shared Supplies:

- 1 small package of Expo Dry erase markers
- 1 ream of computer paper
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 package 3 ½" x 5" note cards (White or multicolored)
- Markers
- Medium size post-it notes

Optional: These are available in the classroom, but if you want your own that is fine.

- Scissors

- 2 composition books (the stitch bound type) with graph paper inside for math work.
- A ream of copy paper- that means 500 sheets- high recycled content is smiled at.
- An extra set of clothes for emergencies contained in a bag with their name on it.
- Either a pack of magic markers and/or colored pencils for personal use (whichever the student prefers) in a container marked with the student's name.
- 2 boxes of tissues for communal use.
- 100 3" X 5" lined note cards.
- 2 glue sticks.
- A white washcloth or new cotton rag for communal cleaning. Honestly, the cheaper the better.
- A backpack to safely transport work and books to and from home.
- 2 lined composition books- the stitched-up type, but feel free to buy the cheapest with a good, hard cover.
- A roll of masking tape.
- One trifold 36X48 cardboard poster. The student's name should be written on the back.
- Students have headphones provided for computer use in class, but students may bring in a pair for personal use that will NEVER be shared with peers.
- One bottle of hand soap to use for the cleaning of hands.
- 3 pocket folders. One is for choir, one is for Spanish, the last one is for transportation of work to and from class every weekend.
- 24 wooden pencils that will be used communally.
- One bottle of rubber cement.

Personal Supplies:

- Pencils (at least 25)
- Pencil top erasers
- One package blue or black ball point pens
- One 2" 3-ring binder (**7th graders only**)
- One package of binder dividers (**7th graders only**)
- 7 pocket folders (plain please- no designs or images, but any solid color is fine)
Please label: English, Social Studies, Science,

Math, Spanish, Music, Art

- 3 composition notebooks - one each for English, Social Studies, and Science (either wide or college ruled): 8th graders may use their Science, Social Studies, and English notebooks from last year; **Rae would like students to use their same Spanish composition book from last year.**
- 1 composition notebook with graph paper for Math
- Scientific calculator similar to TI-30XIIS
- Container (like a pencil box) to hold pencils, pens, etc..

Shared Supplies:

- 2 reams of computer paper
- 1 box of tissues
- 2 large Elmer's glue sticks or 1 jar of rubber cement
- 2 packages of dry erase markers
- 1 package of markers (thick or thin)
- 1 package of index cards (3x5)
