Position requires an ability to organize students into project groups when needed and appropriate.

- Degree in math and or science or comprehensive math-science education
- Previous successful experience in teaching middle school math and science is highly desirable
- Interest in and support for Quaker practices and values

Selected Additional Responsibilities

- Designing clear, demonstrable academic outcomes and activity appropriate for middle school students of varying ability levels
- Partnering with middle school lead teacher in developing learning outcomes and activities designed to foster appropriate social emotional development
- Devise and implement curriculum in both math and science that meets and /or exceeds Indiana State Standards for 7th and 8th graders
- Provide regular assessment of student progress delivered in narrative format and communicated clearly to students and parents/guardians
- Assist in supervising individual student research projects
- Assist students with transitional plans into high school
- Participating in weekly staff meetings
- Partnering with middle school lead teacher in appropriate curricular integration
