I hope that you have all been having many fun adventures this summer. It is hard to believe how quickly the summer days seem to be going by. To get us prepared for the upcoming school year, I have compiled a list of supplies that will be important to have ready by the start of school.

School supplies for shared use:

- Markers – **3** sets of regular Crayola markers and **3** sets of thin line Crayola markers
- **2** packages of colored pencils
- **1** ream of white printer paper
- **2** boxes of tissues
- **1** small bottle of hand soap

(Crayola are preferable as they seem to have longer shelf lives over other brands ☺)

Personal supplies –please label all items with your child's name

- **1** pocket folder (any color or images)
- **3** spiral notebooks with lined paper - 8 1/2" by 11"
- A labeled water bottle that will stay at school
- A complete change of clothing placed in a labeled plastic bag.
- A photograph of you and your family for display on the Family Wall.
- A Lunch Box
- A Backpack (large enough to fit an upright 8 1/2" x 11" piece of paper, or larger)

Family Supply List
Laura's Class: 2023 - 2024

LABEL with your child's first name

- 1 standard-sized, plastic pencil box (approx 8.5" x 6")
- 1 leak-proof, reusable water bottle
- 1 spiral-bound sketchbook
- 1 lunchbox with child's name written on the outside front
- 1 backpack with child's name written on the outside front
- 3 paper (not plastic) folders with pockets with child's name on the outside front
- First-grade and new-to-RFS students only: 1 composition book (not spiral) - traditional marbled style in black and white with name on outside front. These are for Spanish class.
(Second graders will continue using their same Spanish composition books, which Rae has at school.)

DO NOT LABEL (we will keep and share these items)

- 1 ream of white printer paper
- 4 (or more) thick, chisel-tip, dry-erase markers (any colors except yellow)
- 1 box of 50 or 100-count Crayola Super Tips Washable Markers
- 1 large box of tissues (the type that pull out the top)
- Ticonderoga sharpened pencils, 10-pack (or more)
- 2 foaming pump soaps
- Something you'd enjoy playing with at recess (it should be able to get dirty)
- 2 black Sharpies (fine tip)

Bring supplies on the first full day of school (not to the family workday).

RFS 3-4th Grade Classroom Supply List

- 1 ream copy paper OR 1 package wide ruled lined paper
- 1 box tissues
- 1 or 2 packages of at least 4 dry erase markers to donate to the classroom. If students want their own, please bring an extra package for them to keep in their cubby.
- 2 old socks or cloths to be used as dry erase markers (cheap cotton work gloves also work well)
- 1 box of pencils (These will be donated to the classroom)
- 1 box of markers (thick or thin, your choice)
- 2 glue sticks
- 2 pocket folders
- 3 sheets of poster board
- 1 composition notebook for Spanish, last year's is fine

Optional items:

- pencil box Each student will have a plastic bin supplied by the school, but a pencil box to go inside that can be helpful.
- ear buds The classroom has headphones, but if you prefer your own personal ear buds you can bring those.
- scissors. There are scissors in the classroom, but not enough for every student.
- 1 ruler with inches and centimeters

Feel free to keep using notebooks, folders, etc. from last year. They don't need to be new as long as they have plenty of blank pages. There are colored pencils and crayons available in the classroom.

Classroom Supply List for the 5th-6th Grade Class **2023 to 2024 School Year**

All of these items should be brought on the first day of school, Wednesday, August 9, rather than dropped off on the work day before school officially starts or on some random day.

1. 2 composition books (the stitch-bound type) with graph paper inside for math work. Ordering online is sometimes faster than trying to find these locally, but it is not impossible
2. A ream of copy paper- that means 500 sheets- high recycled content is smiled at.
3. Either a pack of magic markers and/or colored pencils for personal use (whichever the student prefers) in a container marked with the student's name. If they are from this past year, make sure they still work.
4. 2 boxes of unused tissues for communal use.
5. 100 3" X 5" white note cards, the kind with lines on one side and no lines on the reverse.
6. 2 glue sticks.
7. A backpack to safely transport work and books to and from home.
8. 3 lined composition books- the stitched-up type with lined paper- but feel free to buy the cheapest with a good, hard cover. They are for my class, Spanish, and music. Spanish and music composition books from last year can be used for the coming year. Those lucky students will only need 1 new composition book.
9. One trifold 36" X 48" cardboard poster. Please don't get one of the smaller ones. If you do, your child will feel like their creative spirit is hampered by the limited area of the board.
10. Students have headphones provided for computer use in class, but students may bring in a pair for personal use that will NEVER be shared with peers. If a pair is brought to class, it should remain in class and not be brought back and forth from home to school each day.
11. One bottle of hand soap to use for the cleaning of hands. Water and paper towels will be provided by the school.
12. Folders with two pockets for Spanish and music to keep track of handouts and homework. Plastic lasts the whole year. Paper folders sometimes have to be replaced. I leave the decision up to you.
13. 24 to 48 pencils for communal use. Ticonderoga are the best. This is not an advertisement for those wonderful writing instruments, so you can bring whatever kind you like or are on sale. Please do not bring in pencils that have a plastic coating on the outside. Some pencils use

this plastic layer so they look nice with pretty designs. However, little plastic bits get stuck in the pencil sharpener and cause problems.

14. One bottle of rubber cement.

15. One package (100 sheets) of lined paper. Wide-ruled only. College-ruled paper may be donated to needy college students.

Middle School Supply List for 2023-2024

Personal Supplies

We encourage you to re-use supplies from last year when possible.

- Pencils (at least 25)
- Pencil top erasers, Hi-Polymer eraser, or Pink Pearl eraser depending on student preference.
- Blue or black ball point pens (at least 6)
- Colored markers
- 2 glue sticks
- 6 pocket folders. Please label: English, Social Studies, Science, Math, Spanish, Music & Art (the last two subjects share 1 folder).
- 6 composition notebooks: one each for Reading, Writing, Social Studies, Science, Music, and Spanish (either wide or college ruled). 8th graders may use their Science, Social Studies, Music, and Reading notebooks from last year but will still need to purchase a new Writing notebook. Rae would like students to use their same Spanish composition book from last year.
- 1 sketch pad, around 9"X12" for Art. If students already have a sketch pad, they are encouraged to use that one. If purchasing a new pad, pick one you like. Canson, Blick, and Strathmore are fine brands.
- 1 composition notebook with graph paper for Math
- Scientific calculator similar to TI-30XIIS. Please make sure you have one with you at school clearly labeled with your name.
- 1.5 or 2 inch 3 ring binder
- Ruler
- Water bottle
- Container (like a pencil box) to hold pencils, pens, etc.
- Decor for inside of locker (optional)
- Hand sanitizer (optional)

Supplies for classroom

- 2 reams of computer paper
- 2 sets of dry erase markers, chisel tip (not fine tipped)
- 12 pack Sharpies (Students and teachers will use these for various projects throughout the year.)
- 2 rolls scotch tape
- 1 box of tissues
- 2 poster boards (22" x 28" or similar)
- 2 pads of 3X3 Post-It notes for the classroom supply
- 1 refill bottle liquid hand soap
- 1 box gallon-size storage reclosable bags (e.g., Ziploc or Hefty Slider) OR 1 box tall kitchen trash bags
