2026-2027 Supply List

Art + Classroom Supplies

- 1 can of shaving cream
- 1 bottle of 16 oz tempera paint (your child's favorite color OR we're low on Red, Orange, Green, and Purple) (Here is a link to an inexpensive option on Amazon if you have trouble finding this! <https://a.co/d/0bGtAIgx>)
- 1 pack of Kwik Stix Tempera Paint Sticks (12 count)
- 1 box of tissues

Daily Essentials

- 1 water bottle – name clearly displayed, leak proof, dishwasher safe (this will remain at school and will be washed weekly or as needed)
- 1 backpack - large enough to hold their lunch box and a 9x12 folder
- 1 lunch box – brought and sent home daily (lunch should not need to be refrigerated or heated. Please provide utensils, if needed)

Quiet Time (Full-Day Students only) These items will be sent home bi-weekly, or as needed, to be washed.

- 1 blanket, large enough to cover their body
- 1 pillow
- 1 stuffed animal (“stuffy”) from home – optional, but encouraged

Clothing

- **2 extra outfit changes** in gallon zip-lock bags labeled with your child's name. Each bag should include:
 - 1 shirt, 1 pair of shorts or pants, socks and underwear
- 1 rain jacket
- 1 pair of rain boots
- 1 extra pair of shoes

Sunscreen and Bug Spray

- We have a variety of sunscreens and bug sprays at the school (Banana Boat, Australian Gold, Defense Zone, Coppertone, Sun Bum, and OFF! clean feel bug spray), but if you or your child prefers a different brand, you are welcome to bring a bottle labeled with their name.
